The City Commission of the City of Sweetwater, Texas, will meet in regular session on Tuesday, September 26, 2017, at 9:00 a.m. in the City Commission Room of the City Hall, 200 E. 4th Street, Sweetwater, TX.

4. Action Items.
 - A. City Commission to vote on a tax rate of \$0.497423 (cents) per \$100 valuation. This tax rate will raise more taxes for maintenance and operations than last year's tax rate by \$4,642, which is a 0.21 percent increase.
 - B. City Commission to consider second and final reading of an Ordinance fixing and levying a tax rate for the tax year 2017 upon all taxable city property within the corporate city limits of the City of Sweetwater, Texas. This year's proposed tax rate of \$0.497423 (cents) does not exceed the effective tax rate. This tax rate will raise more taxes for maintenance and operations than last year's tax rate.
 - C. City Commission to consider ratifying vote on tax rate reflected in the 2017-2018 Annual Budget of the City of Sweetwater
 - D. Resolution: Hear presentation from Halff Associates on 10-year Parks Master Plan, and discuss, consider and act upon resolution adopting the 2017 Sweetwater Parks Master Plan.
5. Public Comments and Receipt of Petitions: *[At this time, anyone will be allowed to speak on any matter other than personnel matters or matters under litigation, for length of time not to exceed three minutes. No Commission/Board discussion or action may take place on a matter until such matter has been placed on an agenda and posted in accordance with law - GC, 551.042.]*
