C. September 2011 sales tax collections were up 115% or \$179,393.77 from 2010. Included in this amount is a single payment of \$132,941.72 (City's portion) from a taxpayer as well as \$6,519.35 audit recovery.

D. Eddy Campbell, Scott Hibbs (Enprotec, Hibbs & Todd), Jim Clements (Oncor) and I met to discuss recent power outages and impact on Water Treatment Plant. Scott Hibbs will bring a report November 8, 2011.
