## CITY OF SWEETWATER, TEXAS CITY COMMISSION MEETING AGENDA

The City Commission of the City of Sweetwater, Texas, will meet in regular session on Tuesday, September 10, 2013 at 9:00 a.m. in the City Commission Room of the City Hall, 200 E. 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Sweetwater, Texas.

- 4. A. City Commission to consider approval of minutes for the meeting held on August 13, 2013.

- A. City Commission to open and consider bids for construction of new police station.
- B. City Commission to open and consider bids for fuel for 2013-2014.
- C. City Commission to open and consider bids for oil and lubrication products for 2013-2014.
- D. City Commission to open and consider bids for hot mix cold lay asphalt for 2013-2014.

- G. City Commission to consider appointment of two SEED Board Directors for a three year term beginning October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2016. Each Commissioner may nominate one person and each Commissioner will have two votes with

- only one vote for his nominee. The two nominees receiving the most votes will be appointed.
- H. City Commission to consider reappointment of Terry Bennett, Gil Cherry, and Keith Brock as alternate, as members of the Board of Adjustments with all having new terms to expire September 30, 2015.
- I. City Commission to consider reappointments of Charles Hamlin, Rhea Hendrix and Laila Sheridan, whose terms expire September 30, 2013, as members of the Planning and Zoning Commission, new terms to expire September 30, 2015.
- J. City Commission to consider second and final reading of an Ordinance Amending the Budget for Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2012 and ending September 30, 2013.
- K. City Commission to consider second and final reading of the Appropriations Ordinance for the 2013-2014 Budget.
- L. City Commission to consider second and final reading of an Ordinance to adopt the 2013-2014 Budget.
- M. City Commission to consider second and final reading of the Ordinance fixing and levying the tax rate of \$.48 (48 cents) per \$100 valuation. This year's proposed tax rate does not exceed the effective tax rate. A motion to adopt an ordinance setting the tax rate does not require the language about "tax increase" as stated in 26.05 (b) of Property Tax Code.
- N. City Commission to consider adoption of a Resolution approving the Investment Policy for Fiscal Year 2014.
- O. City Commission to consider approval of the Financial Policy for Fiscal year 2014.
- P. City Commission to consider approval to pay the full rate to Texas Municipal Retirement System beginning January 1, 2014.
- Q. City Commission to consider whether or not to continue funding opportunity with Texas Water Development Board after Board determined that no disadvantaged funds (grant funds) are available to the City. The mainstream loan offered to the City to develop the

Hunter well field and pipeline is more favorable than market certificates of obligation.
