The City Commission of the City of Sweetwater, Texas, will meet in regular session on Tuesday, October 8, 2013, at 9:00 a.m. in the City Commission Room of the City Hall, 200 E. 4th Street, Sweetwater, Texas.

5. Action Items:
 - A. City Commission to welcome and recognize Leadership Sweetwater participants.
 - B. City Commission to consider approval of the Quarterly Investment Report for the quarter ended September 30, 2013.
 - C. City Commission to consider bids for construction of new police station. Bids were opened September 10, 2013 during the City Commission meeting.
 - D. City Commission to open and consider bids for repairs to the Loop 549 ground storage tank.
 - E. City Commission to consider authorizing staff to purchase an ambulance for EMS through state approved Buy Board low bid.
 - F. City Commission to consider second and final reading of an Ordinance Amending the Ordinance Approving and Adopting a Budget for the City of Sweetwater for the Fiscal Year Beginning October 1, 2013 and Ending September 30, 2014.

- G. City Commission to consider adoption of an Ordinance of the City Commission of the City of Sweetwater, Texas, approving a negotiated resolution between the Atmos Cities Steering Committee and Atmos Energy Corp., Mid-Tex Division regarding the Company's 2013 annual rate review mechanism filing in all Cities exercising original jurisdiction; declaring existing rates to be unreasonable; adopting tariffs that reflect rate adjustments consistent with the negotiated settlement and finding the rates to be set by the attached tariffs to be just and reasonable; requiring the Company to reimburse Cities' reasonable ratemaking expenses; repealing conflicting resolutions or ordinances; determining that this ordinance was passed in accordance with the requirements of the Texas Open Meetings Act; adopting a savings clause; declaring an effective date; providing a most favored nations clause; and requiring delivery of this ordinance to the Company and the Steering Committee's legal counsel.
 - H. City Commission to consider adoption of a Resolution Expressing Official Intent to Reimburse Costs of Water and Sewer System Projects.
 - I. City Commission to authorize eHT to advertise for bids to drill and complete 3 or more municipal water wells on the Hunter Well Field.
 - J. City Commission to consider authorizing staff to purchase a pumper truck for the Fire Department through state approved Buy Board low bid.
 - K. City Commission to consider entering into Executive Session pursuant to the provisions of 551.071 and 551.072 of the Texas Government Code to consult with attorney regarding advice about pending or contemplated litigation and to deliberate on the purchase/sale or lease of real property.
 - L. City Commission to consider returning to Regular Session.
 - M. City Commission to consider possible action from the Executive Session.
