
1. Call to order.

4. City Commission to consider approval of minutes for the meeting held on November 12, 2013.
5. Action Items:
  - A. City Commission to open and consider bids on drilling water wells on City-owned property known as the Hunter Well Field and the construction of a pipeline and other necessary infrastructure, and to consider alternative bids on that project.
  - B. City Commission to open and consider bids for the Union Pacific Railroad right of way waterline relocation project.
  - C. City Commission to consider re-appointment of Elsie Pierce and Carol Cain as City appointees to the County-City Library Board, terms to expire December 31, 2016.
  - D. City Commission to consider re-appointment of Kent Boatright as City appointee and Jo Henderson as joint City-County appointee to the Pioneer Museum Board, new terms to expire December 31, 2015.
  - E. City Commission to consider authorizing the renewal of the contract with Melody's Southwest Consortium for drug and alcohol testing services.

- F. City Commission to authorize City Manager to cast ballot to vote for City's nominee, Ben High, to the Board of Directors of the Central Appraisal District of Nolan County.
  - G. City Commission to consider approval of Sweetwater Enterprise for Economic Development (SEED) purchase of 77.12 acres of land more or less, known as Stevens Property on West Broadway.
  - H. City Commission to consider second and final reading and adoption of an ordinance amending Chapter 25 of the Sweetwater Code of Ordinances, Article IV entitled "procedure for abandoning, altering, closing, and vacating streets, alleys and public ways", by amending Section 25-63 entitled "petition filing fee" by establishing a fee to be incorporated in the City's annual central rate schedule.
  - I. City Commission to consider entering into Executive Session pursuant to the provision of 551.071 of the Texas Government Code to consult with attorney regarding advice about pending or contemplated litigation.
  - J. City Commission to consider entering into Regular Session.
  - K. City Commission to consider any action necessary from the Executive Session.
6. City Manager's Report.
- A. Contractor began sandblasting work on Loop 549 water storage facility December 3, 2013 and should begin painting within 2 weeks, weather permitting.
  - B. Sweetwater Fire Department has taken delivery of new pumper truck. The truck will be available for inspection at City Hall after the meeting.
  - C. Bids for construction of a new proposed police station will be opened and considered at the January 14, 2014 City Commission Meeting.
