The City Commission of the City of Sweetwater, Texas met in regular session on August 16, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. in the City Commission Room at City Hall, 200 E. Fourth Street with the following members present:

- 4. Action Items:
  - Motion was made by Commissioner May, seconded by Commissioner A. Castro to approve second and final reading of an Ordinance approving a negotiated resolution between the Atmos Cities Steering Committee ("ACSC" or "Steering Committee") and Atmos Energy Corp., Mid-Tex Division ("Atmos Mid-Tex" or "Company") regarding the Company's fourth annual rate review mechanism ("RRM") filing in all cities exercising original jurisdiction; declaring existing rates to be unreasonable; adopting tariffs that reflect rate adjustments consistent with the negotiated settlement and finding the rates to be set by the attached tariffs to be just and reasonable; requiring the company to reimburse cities' reasonable ratemaking expenses; repealing conflicting resolutions or ordinances; determining that this ordinance was passed in accordance with the requirements of the Texas Open Meetings Act; adopting a savings clause; declaring an effective date; and requiring delivery of this ordinance to the Company and the Steering Committee's legal counsel. The motion carried unanimously.
